

The Christmas season is fast approaching and part of our themed activities is the ever exciting theatre visit to watch the pantomime!

This year we are going to the Lowther Pavilion for their performance of Snow White. Lowther Pavilion is renowned for its high-quality productions.

We have carefully chosen this theatre due to its excellent safety record and family-friendly environment. The venue is easily accessible, and they are experienced in hosting school groups, ensuring that all students will have a safe and enjoyable experience.

Trip Details:

- Where: Lowther Pavilion, Lytham
- When: Monday 2nd December
- Times: We will be departing school at 8.30am prompt and be back for 1.00pm
- Lunch: Due to the timing of the show this year, the children will be having a picnic lunch in their classroom on our return.

The cost of this activity is £17.30 per child. The cost of the coach is £7.30 per child and the theatre ticket £10.00.

To enable the activity to go ahead we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £17.30. If we do not receive enough voluntary contributions, the activity may not be able to go ahead. However, if your child is either on free school meals, an armed forces service child or a looked after child, school will pay for this trip from the ppg budget unless you are willing and able to meet this contribution...please see ppg statement on the website PP Strategy (bowerham.lancs.sch.uk) for further details of how this is spent.

The trip is payable via ParentPay using a reducing balance which means you can pay as much or little is affordable for you by Friday 29th November.

When you pay for the trip via ParentPay this also indicates that you give your child permission to attend the trip.
