Dear Year 1 Parents and Guardians,

The children have really enjoyed engaging in transport-themed activities this half term so we have decided to book an exciting trip to the Runway Visitor's Park at Manchester Airport on Thursday 7th November. We will enjoy a 2-hour tour inside the cabin of a DC10 aircraft. Here the children will be involved in role-play situations and identify fundamental parts of an aircraft. The children will also have the opportunity to visit the flight deck and sample the feeling of being a Pilot or Flight Engineer.

The total cost of the trip will be £18.70 per child; this is for the cost of entry to the Runway Visitor's Park and the opportunity to join in with their exciting activities. To be able to go on the trip we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £18.70.

If we do not receive enough voluntary contributions, the trip will not be able to go ahead. However, if your child is either on free school meals, an armed forces service child or a looked after child school will pay for this trip from the ppg budget unless you are willing and able to meet this contribution...please see ppg statement on the website <u>https://www.bowerham.lancs.sch.uk/our-pupil-premium/</u>. For PPG children-please confirm in child's communication diary if you wish school to pay this, as this will also act as permission for them to attend the trip.

We completely understand that this may be a large cost to pay in one sum so we would like to offer the option of paying for the trip using a reducing balance on ParentPay. This will mean you can pay in small amounts until the deadline. If you have any difficulties meeting the deadline then please do not hesitate to contact us for support.
