2, The children have had a great first half term in year 5. They have thoroughly enjoyed their learning in History and taking part in the Victorian Trail around Lancaster. The children have enjoyed taking on the roles of different Victorian characters to explore the industrial revolution and the expansion of the railways. The children have also enjoyed their swimming sessions and are looking forward to taking part in the water safety aspect of this. They are also looking forward to meeting their buddies in reception next half term and spending time getting to know them.

In Maths we are looking at number with a focus on the four operations and angles in shape, space and measure. In Literacy we will be planning and publishing an expanded narrative based on Oliver Twist before moving on to a Christmas Carole engaging in a Characters study and a balanced argument of Scrooge's character. In RE, we are learning about Islam with a focus on the key question 'Why is the Qur'an so important to Muslims?' In PSHEE, we will be looking at adult and children's views around smoking and peer pressure as well as working with safenet to learn about our online identity and who to trust. In PE, we are continuing with our school swimming lessons and learning tennis skills. In Music, we are going to be learning to play the Ukulele. 'In Computing, we will be using music creation. In MFL we are learning how to describe space using metaphors in French. In Science, we are learning about living things and their habitats, focussing on plant and animal life cycles and reproduction. In Geography we are learning about coastal features observing coastal areas using digital mapping linked to leisure during the Victorian Era. In Art we will use a range of tools and techniques to create a William Morris Print calendar.
